ORDINANCE NO. 2023-50

An Ordinance of the Pierce County Council Amending Chapter 14.20 of the Pierce County Code, "Parks and Recreation Fees," by Amending Fee Schedules and Adding New Fees for Parks and Recreation Activities and Facilities; Adopting Findings of Fact; and Setting an Effective Date.

Whereas, the Pierce County Parks and Recreation Department (Parks Department) operates various recreation activities, facilities, and golf courses for Pierce County; and

Whereas, it is necessary to make adjustments to the fee schedule to ensure they are commensurate with actual costs of administering and operating these programs and facilities; and

Whereas, a standardization of participation fees and rental fees should be maintained throughout the Pierce County park system; and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of Pierce County to allow the Parks Department to collect fees pertinent to the Department's facilities and activities; and

Whereas, changes to the fee schedule and the associated change in anticipated revenue are reviewed in association with the adoption of the 2024-2025 biennial budget for the Parks Department, effective January 1, 2024; and

Whereas, Pierce County Comprehensive Plan Goal PR-20 directs the Parks Department to "Provide recreation programs that serve regional needs and encourage greater participation in areas not served by other providers;" and

Whereas, in 2020, the Pierce County Council adopted the 2020-2030 Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Plan, which includes a Cost-Recovery Matrix that directs user fees to be calculated based on community versus individual benefit; and

Whereas, the proposed revisions to Chapter 14.20 of the Pierce County Code (PCC), Parks and Recreation Fees, are guided by the Cost-Recovery Matrix; and

Whereas, parks are an essential component of a healthy and vibrant community providing places for people to exercise, connect with nature and other community members, and participate in their communities; **Now Therefore**,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Pierce County:

Section 1. Chapter 14.20 of the Pierce County Code, "Parks and Recreation Fees," is hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The recitals included in this Ordinance are hereby adopted as Findings of Fact describing the Pierce County Council's action.

Section 3. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be January 1, 2024.
